



InfoTrack Easter Egg-stravaganza Promotion

Collect the Eggs Rules:

1. Conduct 5 purchase matters through InfoTrack to collect 12 eggs between the promotional dates of 16th March and 09th April 2020 to be rewarded with a basket of Easter chocolate giftpack. Any transactions falling outside of the specified dates will be ineligible.
2. For a firm to claim the Reward, the firm must collect all 12 egg varieties available throughout the InfoTrack platform.
